

- **Academic Calendar:** The official **Academic Calendar** for **2024/2025** is not issued yet, but I can confirm to you the following for next **Fall Semester 2024/2025** and **Spring Semester 2024/2025**:
  1. **Fall Semester 2024/2025:**
    - **Latest Application Deadline: 31 August 2024**
    - **Registration & Orientation Period: 22 September to 3 October 2024**
    - **Beginning of Classes: 6 October 2024**
  2. **Spring Semester 2024/2025:**
    - **Latest Application Deadline: 31 December 2024**
    - **Registration & Orientation Period: 9 to 20 February 2025 – expected**
    - **Beginning of Classes: 23 February 2025 – expected**
- **Choosing Courses at GJU:** We cannot confirm to you now which courses will be definitely offered next **Fall Semester 2024/2025** and **Spring Semester 2024/2025**! The official **Courses Lists** will be issued almost **two weeks** before the official **Registration Period**, but until that time, we will connect you soon with your **Host Departments** at GJU who can help you with choosing courses and all other academic affairs.

These are all offered programs at GJU:

Incoming students at GJU can register up to **21 Credit Hours** (7 or 8 courses per semester).

Incoming students can choose courses from any **School/Department** and you are allowed to take **Bachelor** and/or **Master** courses, but this must be arranged & approved by your **Home University** and **Host Department**.

The standard conversion method/factor is that 1 Credit Hour at GJU equals 1.5 ECTS. If you would like to get more **ECTS** for our courses, this must be approved by your **Home University** and **Host School/Department**.

The main teaching language at GJU is **English**; so you should be very good in English (**from B2 to C2**). *There are no specific Certificates needed!* There are few courses offered in **Arabic** language, which I can share with your student later.

Classes of most programs take place at the **Main Campus** near Madaba. However, courses of the **School of Architecture & Built Environment**, **Social Work Programs** and most **Master Programs** take place in Amman at **SABE Campus**, mostly in the **evening, from 5:00 pm to 8:00 pm**.

- **Social Work Programs:** There are two programs offered by the **School of Applied Humanities & Languages** that Incoming students can apply for, only if they meet the requirements and get accepted by the **Social Work Department**:
  1. **Professional Training Certificate in Social Work / Migration & Refugees:** It is a 1-semester **Diploma Degree Program**:

2. **Master Program in Social Work / Migration & Refugees:** Incoming students can take any courses from this program:

*PLEASE inform me in advance if you are willing to join one of these programs because your application **MUST be checked and approved** by the Social Work Department first.*

- **Business School (Graduate Programs):** Master students in [Business fields](#), can take courses from the **Graduate** programs of our **Business School**, please check this link for more information: [BS / Graduate Programs](#)

*PLEASE inform me in advance if you are willing to take courses from this school because your application **MUST be checked and approved** by their school first.*

- **Arabic Language courses:** We do not offer preparation language courses for the students before the start of the semester because most of them arrive to Jordan on different dates, but we offer **Arabic Language courses** during the semester. Everything will be arranged according to the students' levels in Arabic language and we have 2 options for the students:
  1. There will be **2** courses offered **ONLY** for Incoming students in **Amia'** (Jordanian dialect), **AFL99** and **AFL100**, for **Beginners & Intermediates**.
  2. There are **2** other courses which are offered for all GJU students in **Fosha** (formal Arabic language), **ARB099** and **ARB100**, but your level in Arabic must be very good (**C1** or **C2**).
- **Pre-Acceptance Application Process:** We will need the following documents by e-mail (sent by the International Office of your university):
  1. Application Form
  2. Transcript of Records
  3. Learning Agreement
  4. Passport Copy
  5. Digital Passport Photo (biometric photo with white background and colors)
  6. CV
- **After-Acceptance "Online" Application Process:** After you are officially **nominated** by your university and **accepted** by the **International Office** and the **Host Department** of GJU, you will be eligible to proceed with the **Online Application Process and Payment** – *more details will be announced later directly with the accepted students.*
- **Studying Fees:** There are different fees for each category – please check the attached file "*Studying Fees at GJU*".
- **Study Buddy Program:** All Incomings will be assigned a **Study Buddy** – a role that is liked very much by Jordanian students.
- **Arrival:** All Incoming students must arrive at GJU at the beginning of the **Registration & Orientation Week** – *more details will be announced later directly to the accepted students.*
- **Visa information:** We will send you the most updated information about this topic asap!
- **Registration at your Embassy in Jordan:** For security and safety reasons, you should register at the Embassy of your country once you arrive to Jordan. For **German** students, this would be the **Elefand** system.

- **Health Insurance:** Although we provide all students at GJU with a mandatory Health Insurance; however, we always recommend them to get another international/travel health insurance in advance before coming to Jordan, because ours is **LIMITED** (doesn't covers all medical conditions), so it will be better to have another one because you might need both of them here.
- **Accommodation:** Unfortunately, we do not have dorms for our exchange students, but we can help with finding good offers.
