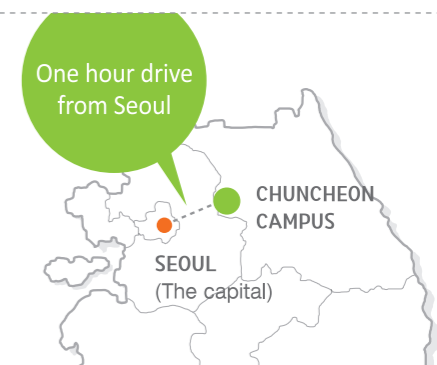

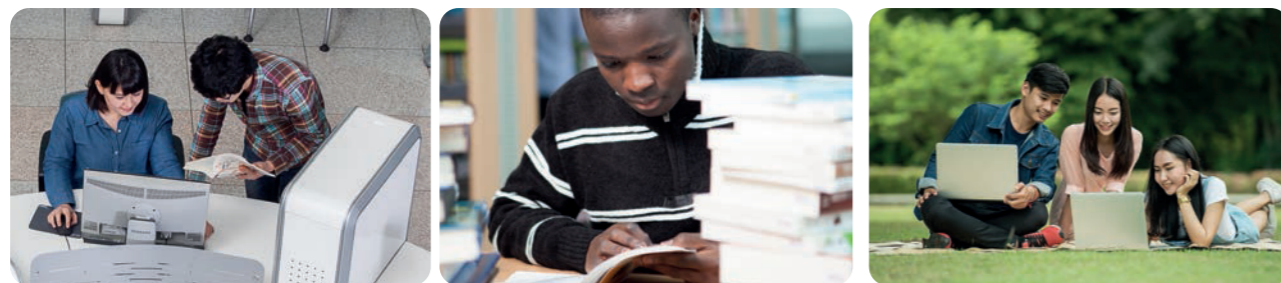

Student Exchange Program

- ▣ **Study period** One or Two semesters
- ▣ **Qualification** Proficiency in Korean or English
- ▣ **Tuition** Exemption for exchange students
- ▣ **Courses** - 90~100 courses taught in English each semester
- Maximum 22 credits each semester

Official Programs



International Summer Program

- ▣ **Period** End of June ~ Early July every year (2 weeks)
- ▣ **Type** Two-credit course
- ▣ **Eligibility** Only undergraduate students interested in Korean Language and culture nominated by KNU's partner universities
- ▣ **Benefit** All costs are covered by KNU (except for the airfare)

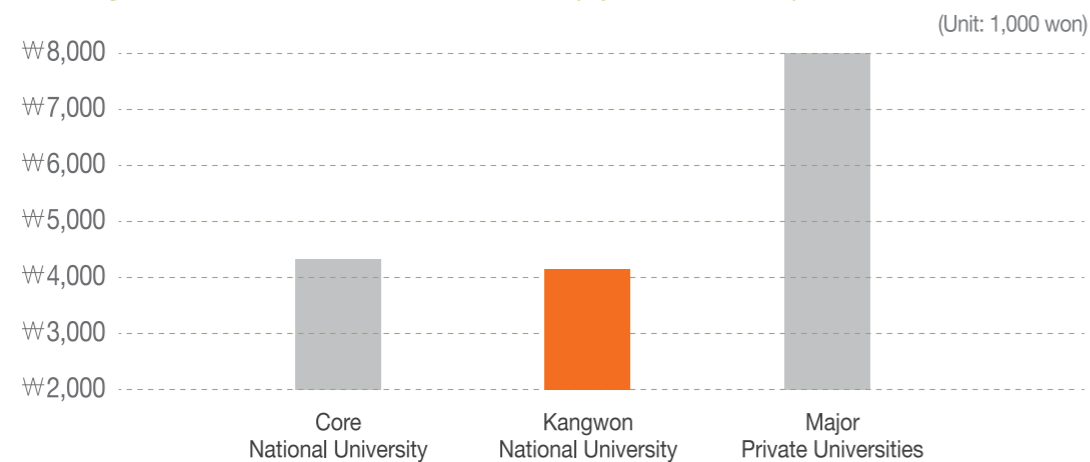
