Established in 1931, Konkuk University (KU) is one of South Korea's leading private universities among the country's 370 higher education institutions. KU has two campuses-the main campus in Seoul and the GLOCAL campus in Chungju-with 23,800 undergraduate and 4,900 graduate students. The university is particularly known for its art and design, biomedicine, business administration, real estate studies, and veterinary medicine departments. With some of the nation's top academic programs and distinguished professors, KU can help you achieve your goals.

Student Life in a Vibrant City

Konkuk's main campus is located in the heart of Seoul, the capital of South Korea. It is just steps away from the Konkuk University subway station, which is serviced by two lines-Line 2 (green) and Line 7 (olive). Line 2 circulates downtown Seoul and offers easy access to almost anywhere in the city, all within one hour. Also nearby the campus is a large shopping mall with a Lotte Department Store, multiplex, and hundreds of cafes and restaurants. Students can leisurely walk over to the Han River Park to bike, swim, and have a picnic as well.

Safe and Friendly Campus

Seoul is a safe city by global standards, and dedicated campus policemen, security guards as well as student volunteers also serve the Konkuk community. For emergencies, 15 call boxes are strategically located to provide direct lines to the campus police. KU is also a diverse, multicultural institution with the Office of International Affairs offering customized services to international students. Through a volunteer program, current KU students assist them in settling down.

Global Partnerships

As of July 2017, KU has partnerships with 565 institutions in 65 countries. Through the partnerships, an increasing number of dual-degree, exchange, and short-term programs are becoming available to both KU and international students. A total of 865 Konkuk students studied abroad and 418 international exchange students were registered at KU in 2017.



STUDY OPTIONS

Exchange/Visiting Student Program

International students may pursue their studies at Konkuk for a semester or two as an exchange student from a partner university or a self-sponsored visiting student. In 2017, Konkuk hosted exchange and visiting students from 31 countries, including students from the University of Mississippi and CSU Channel Islands in the United States, University of Edinburgh in the United Kingdom, Sciences Po Grenoble in France, University of Groningen in the Netherlands, Chuo University in Japan, and City University of Hong Kong.



All international students will be guaranteed a double occupancy room in KU:L House upon request for their first semester. This modern dormitory is located at the center of the campus and overlooks the picturesque Ilgam Lake. Each air-conditioned room has a private bathroom and is completely furnished with two single beds, desks, chairs, lamps, and wardrobes. Telephones and free WiFi are also provided. In addition, various communal facilities are available for the residents' convenience, including a lounge, laundry room, 24-hour convenience store, etc. Students may purchase meal plans to eat at various cafeterias on campus.
